diagnosis tbsrtc - suspicious for a follicular neoplasm or follicular neoplasm ppv 15-30% • composed exclusively of hurthle cells • differential diagnosis is different (medullary ca) • distinction between hca and hcc • surgery (usually lobectomy) is needed for definitive diagnosis tbsrtc - suspicious for a hurthle cell neoplasm ppv 15-45%

FNA of Salivary Gland: Problems and Pitfalls

The differential diagnosis of basaloid lesions includes a number of intrinsic and extrinsic neoplasms that are quite difficult to separate (Table 2) Distinguishing these lesions from each other can be frustrating as neither the cytology nor the histology can always allow for their differentiation The extrinsic lesions are
